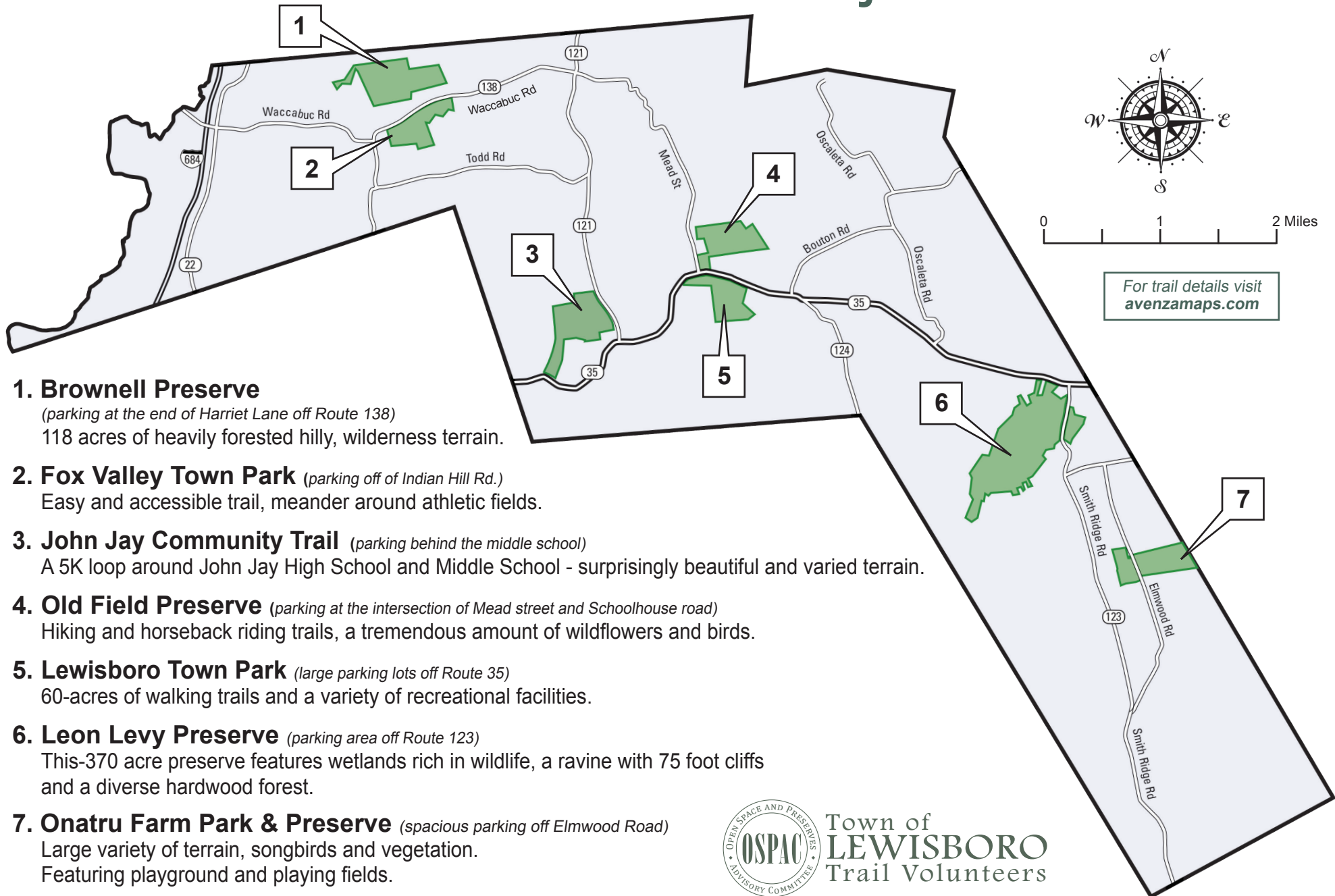


LEWISBORO

TRAILS YOU'LL ENJOY



1. Brownell Preserve

(parking at the end of Harriet Lane off Route 138)
118 acres of heavily forested hilly, wilderness terrain.

2. Fox Valley Town Park

(parking off of Indian Hill Rd.)
Easy and accessible trail, meander around athletic fields.

3. John Jay Community Trail

(parking behind the middle school)
A 5K loop around John Jay High School and Middle School - surprisingly beautiful and varied terrain.

4. Old Field Preserve

(parking at the intersection of Mead street and Schoolhouse road)
Hiking and horseback riding trails, a tremendous amount of wildflowers and birds.

5. Lewisboro Town Park

(large parking lots off Route 35)
60-acres of walking trails and a variety of recreational facilities.

6. Leon Levy Preserve

(parking area off Route 123)
This-370 acre preserve features wetlands rich in wildlife, a ravine with 75 foot cliffs and a diverse hardwood forest.

7. Onatru Farm Park & Preserve

(spacious parking off Elmwood Road)
Large variety of terrain, songbirds and vegetation.
Featuring playground and playing fields.
