

<u>ROSTER:</u>	Frozen as of <b>June 2nd</b> . The maximum roster size is 25.
<u>GAME TIME:</u>	Games will begin at 6:30, unless indicated otherwise on the schedule. If one or both teams have only eight roster players, they may begin the game. If the 9th player has not arrived by the end of a 15-minute grace period, the game will be forfeited. A 9 <sup>th</sup> or 10 <sup>th</sup> player may be inserted into the line-up at any time. They do not need to wait until the bottom of an inning.
<u>RAINOUTS:</u>	The decision to play the game will be made by the Recreation Department by 4:00PM. Every effort will be made to contact the team manager. If it rains after 4:00PM, go to the field where the umpire will make the decision. Please make your players aware of this policy.
<u>OFFICIAL GAME:</u>	A game shall be deemed "official" if 4 innings have been completed with the home team leading.
<u>SUNDAY GAMES:</u>	Due to multiple games scheduled on Sundays, a time limit of 1 1/2 hours will be utilized except the last game scheduled. No new inning will start after 80-minutes.
<u>SHIRTS:</u>	Teams must wear like-colored shirts. Shirts must be worn as of <b>June 2nd</b> .
<u>RULES:</u>	<p>All A.S.A. rules are in effect EXCEPT:</p> <p>Teams may designate a maximum of two (2) players with injuries to receive a courtesy runner. The two players must be indicated to the umpire prior to the start of the game. Runners will be the last batted out.</p> <p>Runner can leave the base on contact only. Batter will be called out if hitter does not make contact with ball.</p> <p><b>A twelve (12) excess run rule is in effect after five complete innings or 4 1/2 if the home team is leading.</b></p> <p>No metal or plastic removable spikes allowed.</p> <p>Strike mat will be used to call strikes or balls (Men only).</p>
<u>LEGAL BATS:</u>	A bat is considered to be legal if it is single wall and does not have a composite or titanium hitting surface.
<u>EXTRA PLAYERS:</u>	Each team is permitted to place two "extra player" positions in their line-ups. These players can be rotated into the field during the course of a game. The "extra player" positions can be added to the line up even after the game has started with their batting position listed at the end of the batting order. Extra player position changes into the field must be made at the end of a half inning. The maximum number of players permitted in the field is 10.
<u>EJECTION:</u>	Any player ejected from a game for a conduct infraction will not be eligible to participate in the team's next played game. A second conduct ejection will result in a suspension of the player.
<u>PROTESTS:</u>	A \$20.00 protest fee, in cash, must be submitted to the umpire at the time of the protest. If the protest is upheld, the money will be refunded.
<u>ILLEGAL PLAYER:</u>	If a team is found to be playing with an illegal player, any game that player has played in will be counted as a loss and the player will be suspended.
<u>PLAYOFF ELIGIBILITY:</u>	Players (Men's Divisions) must participate in a minimum of 3 regular season games to be eligible for playoffs. Players of the Women's Division must participate in a minimum of 1 regular season game to be eligible for playoffs.
