I. Minutes

Motion made by Ian Harris, seconded by Jenn Castelhano to accept the minutes of the March $30^{\rm th}$, 2023 Parks and Recreation Advisory Council meeting.

II. New Business

Summer Camp Pool Changing Area Policy - see attached. The objective of the proposed policy is for the pool changing area to be restricted to campers only while camp is in session. After much discussion, it was decided that camp staff would stay inside as well as outside the changing area while campers were inside and not permit other pool patrons to enter. This will be enforced and will also be posted at the pool facility.

III. Old Business

Lewisboro Playground Committee Update - The chess tables are now in place and wood chips will be delivered next week. The landscaping of the area will be next along with the playground welcome sign and rules. Valerie is working with the Lion's Club on the GaGa pit. The Lion's Club has donated \$300 towards the purchase of a mat to help prevent mud which will be held in place with brackets. The GaGa pit will also be stained. The pavilion roof is in desperate need of repair. The ribbon cutting is set for Saturday, June 3rd at 11:30AM.

IV. Recreation Supervisor's Report

Pickleball Courts - At the last Town Board meeting, it was suggested that Nicole request quotes for the construction of pickleball courts. The Town Engineer does not work with post tension concrete. Nicole met with two dedicated pickleball players who would like to see two courts lined at Fox Valley for pickleball. There has been a donation for new pickleball courts. The Town Park tennis courts can fit up to 16 pickleball courts but there are thoughts to put approximately 8 courts there for approximately \$250,000 plus 10% for additional fees.

Paving - The Town is looking to pave Onatru Farm Park with a grant for approximately \$100,000.

Fireworks Spectacular - Currently working on obtaining sponsors for the Saturday, June $24^{\rm th}$ event.
