Cashless Parks:

Cashless parks this year include: Six Flags, Dorney Park, Citifield, and Lake Compounce. We highly recommend that you send your child with a prepaid debit card for these trips, as many of these trips require them to buy lunch on site. They can also pay with Apple Pay.

1st Day of Camp:

On Monday, June 26th ALL 3-Day and 5-Day campers are invited to join us at the Town Park Pool for a welcome swim party. Campers will be swim tested during the day. **Please drop off and pick up your camper from John Jay High School, or drop them off at their regularly assigned bus stop.** The day is technically a field trip so there will be no drop offs directly at the pool. We will start at 9am at JJHS and dismiss from there at 3pm. Campers will be bussed from the high school to the pool like any other field trip.

Late pick-ups:

As noted in the handbook, the Town will charge \$20/child per every 15 minutes of supervision past program end time with the first 15 minutes as a grace period (unless the grace period is abused consistently.)

If your camper is signed up for the bus and is **not** labeled as able to walk home, that camper will be transported to After Camp and the same fees apply.

Remind App:

Please sign up for the Remind app this camp season. We will be using it to send texts to alert parents of late arrivals due to traffic, early arrivals due to weather, trip changes due to weather, etc.

Extra Money:

This trip, including meals and lodging, is completely paid for. However, there are drink and snack vending machines as well as a candy shop with souvenirs. If you'd like to send your child with extra money for any of these things, you are welcome to do so.

EMT/Nurse:

Club Getaway does not have an EMT/Nurse on site. We are working on bringing one with us for the trip. Our directors, assistant directors, and myself are all certified in CPR and first aid. The staff on site at Club Getaway are also trained in first aid.

Sleeping Arrangements:

The cabins at Club Getaway sleep 8-10 campers per cabin. They are all equipped with air conditioning and the beds are made up with pillows, blankets, and sheets. Each cabin has its own bathroom with a shower.

Staff will be sleeping in cabins next to the campers. We will have a rotating schedule beginning at "lights out." At least 2 adults/counselors will be stationed outside of the cabins to monitor the campers and to ensure their safety. We will also be placing tape on the doors to make sure that campers stay in their respective cabins throughout the entirety of the night.

Groups for cabins:

Each camper will have the opportunity to choose **one** friend they'd like to stay with overnight. They will then be placed in groups based on their requests.

Bag Checks:

Bag checks will be conducted by our staff prior to departing on the morning of Wednesday, July 26th. More information on this is included in the waiver for bag checks.

Staff:

The entire Teen Treks staff will be present on this trip. All directors, assistant directors, and counselors from both our 3-Day and 5-Day programs are scheduled to attend.
