 - o Provide necessary personal details (e.g., date of birth, contact information).
 - o For minors, you will be prompted to include the parent or guardian's name and date of birth.
3. Read the Waiver: Carefully review the terms and conditions outlined in the waiver. Scroll to the bottom and check the box to confirm you have read the waiver.
4. Sign the Waiver:
 - o After signing, you will receive the prompt "Please continue to the front desk." This means you are all set for your event!
